However, walk-ins are always excepted and welcomed so if you don't see a time you would like to come open just show up and they will fit you in. You can go to <https://www.redcrossblood.org/give.html/donation-time> to donate blood for our blood drive. Enter Sponso-Code: VictoryL to go to the Victory Blood Drive site and just pick a time. Notify me if you want a time already taken I might be able to add you in as well. Or again you can do a walk-in as mentioned before.

We are also looking for food donations for the Red Cross workers. We provide dinner for them. - ◆ **Victory 5K** – It's that time of year again when we start to enjoy the warm weather and look forward to the summer days ahead. One of my favorite days of the summer is Victory's Outdoor Service Sunday, which includes the Running for Victory 5K. At this event, we welcome visitors to run and walk beside us, and stay for a church service and potluck. August 5, 2018 will be the date, and there is always much to do to put on a seamless event.

1. **Fundraising** – We need to raise around \$2,000 to support the race (insurance and shirts), facility rentals, and other fun things like the bouncy house. Other ways to volunteer are through photography, making food for the potluck, helping set up for the outdoor worship service, ushering, cheering on runners/walkers, and helping with the Kid's Fun Run! We need YOU to show up for Victory on August 5th!

Unless you're working the finish line or doing race photography, you can pretty much volunteer for anything during the day and still participate in the 5K itself. Thank you in advance for this team effort. Not only do we get to witness outside of the doors of VLC, but this is a chance for us to meet new people, train for the 5K, be in fellowship with one another, and grow the awareness of VLC in our community.
